

In wake of COVID-19 pandemic along with nationwide Lockdown the time table for MSBTE summer 2020 exams has been reseted. The following decisions have been taken.

1. Final semester exams for the students of final semester shall be conducted in the respective institute. The question papers shall be provided by MSBTE.
2. The students of final semester has to appear for all backlog papers compulsory. The exams for backlog for these students shall be commence from 01/07/2020. MSBTE shall display the timetable on its website.
3. All students of final year having backlogs in previous semester or having WFLS / WFLY shall appear for exams (institute level) during 1st Week of July 2020.
4. The performance of 2nd terminal test for Even semester are not be considered and hence the marks for sessional and Progressive Assessment shall be considered on the basis of 1st terminal test and micro project.
5. The Theory and Practical exams of regular students of 2nd and 4th Semester have been waived off. For declaring the result of 2nd and 4th semester 50 % marks of previous semester ie. 1st and 3rd semester with 50% marks obtained in internal assessment of Regular semester (i.e. 2nd and 4th Sem).

Explanation:

Student A scored 62% marks in 1st semester and has scored 66% in internal evaluation in 2nd sem, then marks for 2nd sem will be evaluated as following $(62+66/2=64\%)$.

6. In case the student is ineligible as per rule RG4C for the next semester due to fail / LSP shall be considered eligible provided they will have to clear all the backlogs of previous semester whose exams shall be conducted by the institute level before commencement of winter 2020 exams for session 2020-2021. Students shall be eligible for re-evaluation as per board rules.
7. For current regular students the total attendance shall only be considered on successful completion of assignments/work given during the period of lockdown.
8. Final semester students have to appear for board examinations without effecting board's examination rules and teaching scheme of syllabus.

Considering 90% completion of syllabus prior to lockdown and up to 13/03/2020 the examinations shall be taken and marks shall be converted into 100%.

Explanation:

If as per examination scheme TH head is of 70 then it will be treated that whatever marks is been scored by the student is out of 63 (90% of 70). It means if the student has scored 50 shall now be considered as 56 [i.e. $(50/63)*70=56$]

9. Board Practical's shall be conducted in last week of June 2020 for final semester students. In case student is unable to attend the exams he shall be given marks based on journals, internal examination and oral examination. Oral / practical internal and external examiners shall be from the same institute only and can be conducted on Skype / other platforms.
10. Giving an opportunity to the students who were unable to fill exam forms shall now have to fill the examination forms by 2nd week of June 2020. A separate notification in this regard shall be circulated by the board.
11. Results of the students whose exam forms have been confirmed by the divisional office shall be declared.
12. A separate notification shall be given for industrial training after 4th sem of I scheme.
